### **Branch Librarian**

The Delphi Public Library is searching for an enthusiastic, innovative person to join its staff as Branch Librarian. This position includes approximately 40 hours a week, with some weekend and evening shifts required. The ideal candidate will be flexible, creative, and self-directed with communication and social skills that allow interaction with the public in a friendly, professional, and responsive manner. Primary duties include collection development for all branch collections, providing reference and reader's advisory services, and staffing the circulation and reference desks.

The minimum librarian certification level for this position is LC6, which requires 3 years of library work experience or 9 hours of college level Library Science credit (any 3 courses).

Starting wage depends on education and experience, with a minimum base pay of \$16.00 or \$19.25 depending upon education. Benefits include paid holidays, vacation, and sick leave. Position available immediately and remains open until filled. Delphi, designated as a Stellar Community by the State of Indiana, is located 18 miles northeast of Lafayette along the Hoosier Heartland Corridor.
